## EDUCATION, EMPLOYMENT, YOUTH & FAMILY SERVICES

**353** adult students enrolled in and received **8,672** hours of English as a Second Language instruction. **404** Latino students in Pierce County High Schools & Middle Schools received **766** hours of tutoring and mentorship in the Youth Services after school programming and summer leadership program. **628** families received support services through Outreach and Domestic Violence Services, educational forums and **6** individuals received **48** hours of culturally competent psychological counseling for sexual assault/abuse. **160** families received in-home evidence-based parenting education, childhood development assessment and referral through the Family Support Partnership. **88** low-income, at-risk youth ages 14-24 received employment & training services and **446** individuals sought assistance in their job search by either reviewing the job book, getting resume preparation assistance, participating in mock interviews, etc. Over **2,000** individuals received referral support by calling Centro Latino's main office. **72** families
